'TURNER - THE SUN IS GOD'

English painter, water-colourist and printmaker, Joseph Mallord William Turner (1775-1851) is today widely recognised as the greatest landscape painter of the Romantic period.

Fondation Gianadda's exhibition of 1999, 'Turner and the Alps,' was an enormous success. Now they are presenting a new exhibition, shedding light on different aspects of Turner's artistic development and celebrating his fascination with light and atmosphere through over 100 paintings and water colours.

In the final weeks of his life, Turner famously declared 'The Sun is God,' inspiring the title of this exhibition and hinting at the artist's devotion to capturing this ubiquitous force. Turner's works confront the viewer with a sensory experience of nature that is as affecting today as it was for his contemporaries.
