Visit of the castle of Aigle - Saturday 3rd September

Visit at 11 am

Lunch at “La Pinte du Paradis” at 1 pm

Located in the heart of the Chablais Vaudois, surrounded by vineyards, the castle of Aigle was built in the twelfth century. Partly burned down by the Bernese during their occupation of the region in 1475, the castle was rebuilt and transformed by them in the late 1480s and the current square tower dates from that period. Nowadays, as well as letting out rooms for receptions, banquets and seminars, the castle keeps its cultural wine traditions alive by housing the wine, vineyard and wine labels museum, which we shall visit.



After that we shall have lunch in the « Pinte du Paradis », to be found in the « Maison de la Dime » just opposite, hopefully on their superb terrace with its magnificent view of the Alps and the lake.

The club will provide plastic plates, plastic cups and forks, as well as napkins, aluminium foil for the meat, etc.

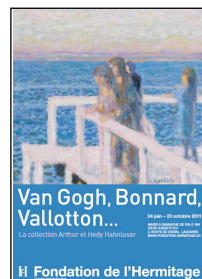
Arthur and Hedy Hahnloser collection at the “Fondation de l’Hermitage”, Lausanne

Thursday 22nd September

Meeting at the entrance at 6pm for visit starting at 6:30 pm

Dinner at around 8 pm

One of Europe's most prestigious private collections, built up by Arthur Hahnloser and his wife Hedy between 1905 and 1936 in Winterthur, this was the fruit of the couple's encounters and friendship with many artists including Ferdinand Hodler, Giovanni Giacometti, Félix Vallotton and Pierre Bonnard, who introduced them to the Parisian artistic scene and advised them on their choice of purchases. Most of the works in the collection were bought direct from the artists' studios or the great Parisian art dealers. The exhibition features the masterpieces from the Villa Flora presented exclusively in Lausanne with other treasures originally in the Hahnloser collection and now in museums or in private hands.



We are looking forward to our guided visit (in French) of this exhibition, meeting at 6 pm at the entrance for the tour starting at 6.30 pm. Afterwards we shall have dinner around 8 pm in the museum's restaurant, « L'esquisse ». Hope you will join us! Prices: Admission CHF 18.- (Adults), CHF 15.- (Seniors), plus guided tour CHF 5.— (Limited number of participants and no advanced booking possible, so make sure you sign up in time!)
